



## How To Add Dot Labels To Moon Plots

### Problem

*Correspondence analysis Moon Plots* use text labels to show the position of the row labels (e.g., brands) on the moon's surface. The centres of these labels show the position of the label on the moon. In some cases this may not suffice and you would rather prefer a dot to show the position of the label.

### Steps to solve

1. Create the moon plot.
2. Click in one of the labels you wish to change and press the **Home** button on your keyboard.
3. Press the **Enter** button on your keyboard.
4. Insert a dot or whatever symbol you prefer using PowerPoint.
5. Press the **Enter** button again.
6. Centre the paragraph (e.g., press **Ctrl+E**).
7. Repeat this process for each of the points. If you are a proficient user of PowerPoint, you can do this quickly by selecting all of the points and centring them at the same time, and using cut and paste for each point for the returns and symbol.
