



How To Add Dot Labels To Moon Plots

Problem

Correspondence analysis Moon Plots use text labels to show the position of the row labels (e.g., brands) on the moon's surface. The centres of these labels show the position of the label on the moon. In some cases this may not suffice and you would rather prefer a dot to show the position of the row labels instead.

Steps to solve

1. Create the moon plot.
2. Click in one of the labels you wish to change and press the **Home** button on your keyboard.
3. Insert a dot or whatever symbol you prefer using PowerPoint.
4. Press the **Enter** button. Note that the symbol you have inserted now shows the position of the row label.
5. Repeat this process for each of the points.
