



How To Crosstab using a Pick One - Multi question

Problem

You wish to see how a **Pick One – Multi** question differs by groups by crosstabbing it with another question. Sometimes this is called creating a “layered table” or “nesting”.

Steps to solve

1. In the **Variables and Questions tab**, right click on the **Pick One - Multi** question of interest.
2. Select **Insert Ready-Made Formula(s)** and **Pick One - Multi -> Pick Any (Flatten)**.
3. You can choose to nest within rows or columns.
4. Double click on the row header of the newly created question to view it in the **Tables tab**
5. Select another question in the brown drop-down to crosstab.
