



How To Turn Text Variables Into Numeric Variables

Problem

A data file has been provided which contains numerical data, but where the **Question Type** has been set as being **Text**. For example, the data may be a weight variable, number of times a particular product has been purchased, price paid, etc. In this case, you want to set up the data as numeric. (e.g., to compute an average).

Steps to solve

1. Select the question of interest in the in the Blue Drop-down menu.
2. Press the arrow button to the right of the Blue Drop-down menu.
3. Change the **Variable Type** from **Text** to **Numeric**. A new variable will have been created, immediately beneath the other variable.
4. Double click on the row number of the new variable, and you will return to the **Tables** tab with the new question being displayed in the Blue Drop-down menu.
