



## How To View Total Ratings For A Pick One - Multi

### Problem

A question is of type **Pick One – Multi** (e.g., ratings of banks on a five point satisfaction scale) and you want to create a net of the total ratings.

### Steps to solve

1. In the **Variables and Questions** tab, select the variables you want to combine.
2. Right-click, select **Insert Ready-Made Formula(s)** and **Questions -> Pick Any with All Combinations**.
3. View the new question in the tables tab. This will show net ratings for all banks.
